Itinerary / Program

Day 01

Arrival Borispol – Kyiv International Airport, meet and greet and transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

Day 02

After breakfast, you will start your city tour with an English Speaking Guide visiting:

- **The Golden Gate:** one of the few monuments of defensive architecture of Kyiv Rus' during the reign of Yaroslav the Wise.
- **Sophia Square:** A historic Center of Political Life
- **Vladimir's Cathedral:** The main Temple of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church Kyiv Patriarchate, located in Kyiv on the Boulevard of Taras Shevchenko.
- **St Michael Cathedral:** One of the oldest Monasteries in Kyiv. Involves the destruction in 1930 and re-build in the mid 1990's the Cathedral Church of the Archangel Michael in the Ukrainian Baroque style, as well as a refectory with the Church of St John the Divine (1713) and Bell Tower (1716 -1719).



14:00 — **Excursion to Sofiivskiy Monastery:** Sofiivskiy Monastery was built in the XI century in the city center by order of Yaroslav the Wise. At the turn of XVII-XVIII centuries was apparently rebuilt in the Ukrainian Baroque Style. Inside the Cathedral are numerous ancient frescoes and mosaics, including the famous mosaic of Virgin Orans. St Sophia Cathedral became the first entered in the UNESCO world heritage monument of architecture in the territory of Ukraine. Overnight in Kyiv

Day 03

After breakfast and around **10:00** you will start your excursion to Pecherska Lavra with an English Speaking guide. Kyiv -Pechersk Lavra is a real Spiritual Center of Ukraine and one of the first of the founding Monasteries in "Kievan Rus". Founded in 1051 by monk Antony and Feodosiy, it is the most famous monastery in all Ukraine and became the holy place for all Orthodox Christians. It combines majestic churches, built in classical, Byzantine and Baroque Style. Also on a territory of the monastery you can find a lot of museums; Museum of Historical Treasures and Jewellery, the Museum of Ukraine Decorative and applied Art, the Museum of Miniatures. Also Lara is known for its cave with ancient Crypts, a native of Lubech.

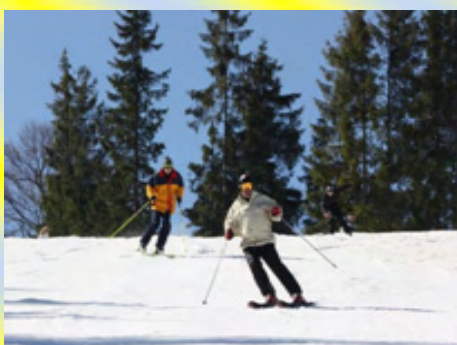
12:30 – excursion to Museum of World War with English-speaking guide. National Museum of the Great world War of 1941-1945 in Kiev is a memorial, located on the picturesque slopes of the right bank of the Dnieper River on the outskirts of Pechersk, one of the historic districts. Hotel check-out, transfer to the train-station.

21:21 - Night-train to Ivano-Frankivsk. (Tickets will be delivered to the hotel). Overnight in the Train.

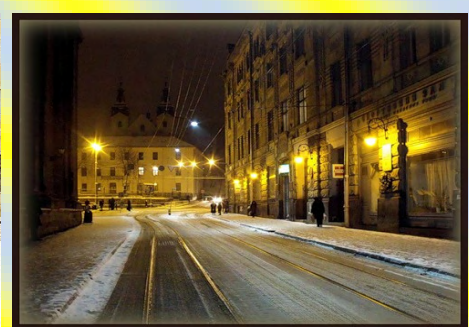

Bukovel Ski Resort

Bukovel Resort has a rapidly growing reputation for being one of the most wonderful ski resorts in Eastern Europe. The resort includes lovely accommodation, modern ski equipment, great restaurants, a fitness centre, a sauna complex, conference hall facilities and many outstanding ski runs for both day and night skiing.

The resort is a new large and extremely modern ski resort in Ukraine's Ivano-Frankivsk oblast 30 km to the west of Yaremcha and is located in the village of Polyanytsya. It is Ukraine's first world-class resort, with 14 ski lifts, meticulously groomed slopes covering 50 kms and snowmaking machines. Bukovel resort has been carefully planned to make skiing and snowboarding fun and convenient and to avoid lift lines and congestion. Lift queues longer than five minutes are rare.

Ski Slopes

Bukovel's base elevation is nearly 900 m above sea level, and the highest ski lift rises to Mt Dovga at 1370 m (see map of Bukovel), making Bukovel the second highest ski resort in the Ukrainian Carpathian Mountains after Dragobrat. The resort's slopes have been designed to cater for all levels of skiing experience, namely beginners, intermediate and difficult. There are also very gentle slopes for children, which includes a children's playground. Night skiing for an additional charge is available from 17:00 to 20:00 on two slopes that are upper intermediate. Bukovel is a rapidly growing resort not only in its expansion but also in its popularity.

Lift Passes and Ski Rentals

Ski lift passes are available to purchase from just a couple of hours to 10 days. Our package holiday include ski lift passes and High quality ski. Snowboard equipment is available for hire from quite a few locations around the resort for your convenience. The resort renews its ski hire equipment annually.

Food

Bukovel has several high quality restaurants. The main restaurant is Kozachok and there is also a pizzeria and a delightful outdoor cafe based halfway up the mountain and reachable by ski lift. Dotted around the resort are fast food outlets for your convenience

Accommodation

Located in the heart of Bukovel Ski Resort is Bukovel Hotel. The hotel comprises of blocks of lovely timber buildings which include double, triple rooms and suites all with en-suite bathrooms. Chalets are available.

Sauna and Solarium

You can relax in the sauna at Bukovel, dip into a cooling pond and feel bursts of energy and relaxation after training. There are two types of saunas at Bukovel : "Ukrainian bath" and "Finnish bath", where the chaise-longues are made of natural wood. Medicinal tea made of the Carpathian herbs and professional masseur's services will also be offered to you. You will also be able to suntan in the solarium during any season.



Basically, what happens to the body during a sauna is quite simple — your metabolism and pulse rates increase, your blood vessels become much more flexible, and your extremities benefit from increased circulation. Physical fitness fans will recognize that some of these changes can also be achieved through strenuous exercise. Not to say a sauna would put you in excellent physical condition without moving a muscle (don't some of us wish!), but that it brings about the same metabolic results as physical exercise. The effects of the sauna are numerous and varied. Proponents of dry heat bath mention a feeling of psychological peace and contentment as well as physical rejuvenation. Many people claim that the sauna relieves the symptoms of minor illnesses such as colds, revives the muscles after tough physical exertion, and clears the complexion. The sauna experience will often leave you feeling very much alive. Your senses will be sharpened, and your tactile sensitivity heightened. Another aspect of the sauna that needs to be considered is your mental state prior to taking one. Many people attest to the healing powers of the sauna concerning mental depression and anxiety. They say that after leaving the sauna, the mind is in a relaxed, lucid state, free of the worries of the everyday world. Also, when the body feels soothed and energized, the mind and emotions often follow suit. The Sauna and Fitness Centre at Bukovel are both housed in the same traditional wooden building. Not only is all the equipment and facilities on offer very modern they are also very comfortable and have well furnished lounges where guests can relax.

Relaxing Massages

Massage therapy is the systematized manipulation of soft tissues for the purpose of normalizing them. Practitioners use a variety of physical methods including applying fixed or movable pressure, holding, or causing movement to the body. Therapists primarily use their hands, but may also use their forearms, elbows, or feet. The basic goal of massage therapy is to help the body heal itself and to increase health and well-being.

Touch is the core ingredient of massage therapy and also combines science and art. Practitioners learn specific techniques for massage and use their sense of touch to determine the right amount of pressure to apply to each person and locate areas of tension and other soft-tissue problems. Touch also conveys a sense of caring, an important component in the healing relationship. When muscles are overworked, waste products such as lactic acid can accumulate in the muscle, causing soreness, stiffness, and even muscle spasm. Massage improves circulation, which increases blood flow, bringing fresh oxygen to body tissues. This can assist the elimination of waste products, speed healing after injury, and enhance recovery from disease.



Vacuum massage – special course, created for improvement of blood circulation, lymphodrainage, muscle tone improvement, general relaxing effect. It can be applied with the medical purpose as well as for rehabilitation and prophylaxis. Massotherapy for medical treatment and prophylaxis of support motor apparatus, gastrointestinal tract and other diseases.
